
Fun Learning Activity: Guessing Game for Kids on Valentine's Day

Activity Description

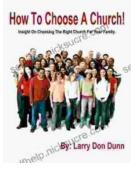
