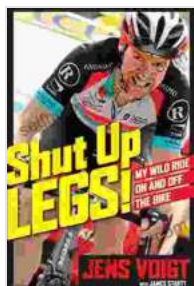

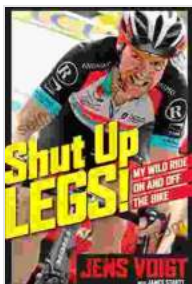


## Looking Ahead

Thank you for following my journey. I hope that my story has inspired you to pursue your own dreams and to never give up on what you believe in.

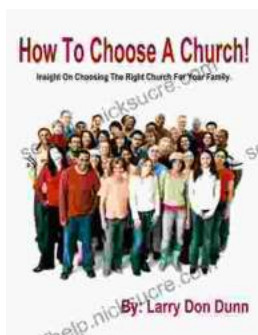


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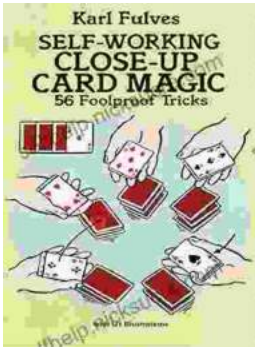
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
